Following our 6 ends we retired to the club house for a dinner of Pizzas

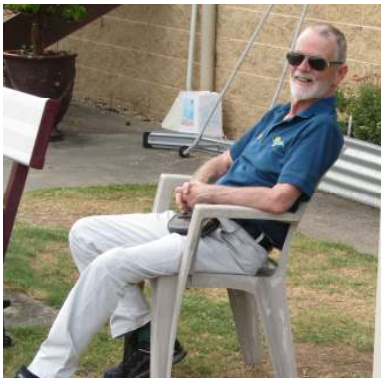
